### Durability

Sir Walter DNA Certified Buffalo is designed to handle the demands of an active backyard. Its surface runners knit the lawn together into a solid turf base, giving it the strength to withstand everyday use while maintaining a lush appearance. This growth habit also helps the lawn repair itself, gradually covering over small gaps and wear areas to keep it looking complete and healthy. Families, pets, and regular foot traffic are well supported by Sir Walter's natural resilience, making it a reliable choice for busy outdoor spaces.

### Drought Tolerance

Sir Walter develops a deep root system that allows it to make the most of available moisture. With proper watering practices, it remains vibrant and attractive through the warmer months, holding its condition and colour for long periods. This makes it a dependable choice for maintaining a green lawn in summer.

### Shade Tolerance

One of the key advantages of Sir Walter DNA Certified Buffalo is its ability to thrive in areas with limited direct sunlight. It performs strongly in partially shaded yards where other grasses may struggle, making it an excellent choice for gardens with trees, pergolas or high fences. This shade adaptability allows you to achieve a green, healthy lawn even in challenging light conditions.

## Maintenance

### Mowing

Sir Walter is best kept at a moderate mowing height, generally around 30–50mm, which helps maintain its density and rich colour. During the warmer months, regular mowing every 1–2 weeks will keep the lawn looking neat and healthy. In winter, growth naturally slows in South Australia's cooler climate, so mowing can be reduced to once every 4–6 weeks. Always use sharp blades to achieve a clean cut and avoid scalping.



### Watering

Once established, Sir Walter benefits from deep, infrequent watering rather than light, frequent watering. In South Australia's dry summers, a thorough soak once or twice a week encourages deeper roots and better resilience. In winter, rainfall is usually sufficient and additional watering is rarely required. Adjust watering based on seasonal conditions and local watering guidelines.

### Fertilising

Sir Walter responds well to a balanced fertilising program. In South Australia, feeding in early spring helps kick-start new growth after winter. A second application in early summer supports the lawn

through the hottest months, while an autumn feed strengthens it before cooler weather sets in. Choose a slow-release fertiliser formulated for buffalo lawns to maintain strong colour, healthy growth, and long-lasting results.

## Dimensions and Delivery Information

Sir Walter is harvested in flat sheets, two per square metre. Each Sheet is 400mm x 1.2m).
